




# Get your own Time Travel Passport pack

### Walking to

### Amberley Museum from Amberley Station

The walk takes roughly 5 minutes on one path. Amberley Station is an unmanned station which means there are no staff to help you.

There is step free access from platform 2 **ONLY** so make sure you check which platform you are arriving on prior to travelling.

Walk out of the main exit from platform 2 of Amberley Station and cross Station Road.

Pass through the gate. Follow the flat path down all the way to the main ticket office at the Museum entrance.

- Pay attention to any announcements at the station and on the train
