## Top tips

We asked our panellists what their top tips for success in the sector were, here are the highlights:

- 1) Be curious, ask questions and get involved – the sector is broad so there is always opportunity to move around
- 2) Qualifications are important but don't be put off by this – always think about the values of the organisation you want to work with and consider how they align with your own
- 3) Work experience is really important. It's a great way to practice communication skills that are vital for all roles in the sector
- 4) The sector is incredibly diverse so where possible, try to travel and understand different cultures and perspectives
- 5) Find a good mentor or coach that can help you and keep you focused during your learning
