



LEWES STATION

### Walking to Anne of Cleves House from Lewes Station

This walk takes roughly 8 minutes  
and is on flat pathways.

Walk out of the front of Lewes Station  
onto Station Road. Turn left towards  
the roundabout.

Before the roundabout use the  
crossing to walk onto the right hand  
side of the road.

Turn right at the roundabout and  
continue to the next mini roundabout.  
Cross straight over the mini  
roundabout and continue onto  
Southover High Street where Anne of  
Cleves House will be on your right.

staff or a Help Point






How you might like to use your map:
