

SHOREHAM-BY-SEA STATION

Walking to

Marlipins Museum from Shoreham-By-Sea Station

This walk is roughly 10 minutes on flat pavements and you will need to cross some roads

Walk out of the main entrance of Shoreham-By-Sea Station. Turn right and walk to the end of the road and then turn left onto Brunswick Road.

Walk to the end of Brunswick Road. When you get to the Methodist Church, cross over the road and turn right on to St Marys Road.

Just before you reach the graveyard, turn left onto East Street and continue to the High Street which runs along the River Adur. Turn right and keep walking until you reach Middle Street, where the Museum will be on your right.

Top tips for travelling by train

- Plan your journey, check for delays or changes before you leave on the National Rail website: www.nationalrail.co.uk

- Keep your ticket safe
- Pay attention to any announcements at the station and on the train
- If you need help find a member of station staff or a Help Point




